

ORDER ON IA

IA-I is filed by the petitioners by praying interim monthly maintenance of Rs.6,000/- each from the respondent for her and her son's for basic needs.

It is stated in the affidavit and petition that, petitioner No.1 is legally wedded wife of Respondent. The petitioner No.2 is their son. Further the petitioner No.1 and respondent spent married life together for 5-6 years and thereafter the respondent has been giving torture to the petitioner No.1 by harassing her by telling that to bring dowry from her parental home and he has not fed her,

thereafter he thrown her out from the house, hence now she is residing with her mother and brother. Therefore, now she is unable to maintain herself and her son. Respondent is doing business and earning. Hence, She prayed for monthly interim maintenance.

Heard on IA-I. As per the prayer of petitioner, she requires amount for her food, cloths and shelter and medical expenses and also to look after her son. She pleaded her inability i.e., economically and physically and also respondent has driven her out of home. At this juncture, on perusal of available materials on the record, the petitioner No.1 has established the marriage between herself and respondent and I am of the opinion that the petitioner has shown the prima facie case to grant exparte interim maintenance for her livelihood. Hence, I proceed to pass the following

ORDER

The respondent is directed to pay interim maintenance of Rs.3,000/-p.m. each to the petitioners till further order.

Issue notice on main petition and order on IA No.I to the respondent if PF paid.
