Case Called out, plaintiff and defendants are present. Counsels for plaintiff and defendants are also present. Counsel for defendants files application U/o. 32 Rule7 of CPC by seeking permission by defendant No. 7 to enter into compromise on behalf of minor defendant No.10 and 11. Heard and since the terms of compromise appear to be protecting the interest of minor plaintiffs, the said application is hereby allowed and defendant No. 7 is permitted to enter into compromise on behalf of minor defendant No. 10 and 11. The plaintiff and defendants have compromised their dispute. Suit is for partition and separate possession. Both parties have submitted Compromise Petition U/o 23 Rule 3 R/w Sec.151 of CPC. The contents of the compromise petition are read over and explained to the parties. The parties have admitted and consented to the terms of compromise petition. The parties before the Court submit that there are no other legal heirs or successors to the suit property. I have perused compromise petition, the parties before the Court submit that they have voluntarily accepted the compromise petition and signed the same. I am satisfied that the compromise is not against the public policy. Hence, compromise petition is accepted. The suit is decreed in terms of compromise petition and compromise petition shall form part and parcel of the decree. The parties shall bear their own costs. Draw Final compromise Decree accordingly on production of NJ stamps.
