:: ORDER ON IA FILED U/O XXIII RULE
3 R/W SEC 151 OF CPC::

The plaintiff, defendant No.1 to 8 along with their counsel have filed a compromise petition under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of CPC and have submitted that they have compromised the matter.

2. This is a suit filed by the plaintiff against defendant No.1 to 8 seeking the relief of Partition and Separate Possession. Both parties have submitted a compromise petition.

3. The contents of compromise petition is read over and explained to the parties. The parties have admitted and consented to the terms of compromise petition. I have perused compromise petition.
