

ORDER BELOW EXH.01
(Passed on 15.07.2026)

1. The applicants have filed this application for getting heirship certificate in respect of late Manohar @ Mahadu Vitthu Jagtap under Bombay Regulation VIII, 1827.
2. According to the applicants, Manohar @ Mahadu Vitthu Jagtap was the common ancestral of their family and Sugandhabai Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap was his wife. Manohar @ Mahadu and Sugandhabai is having only one son i.e. Suresh Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap. Applicants are the wife and children of deceased Suresh. Manohar @ Mahadu passed away on 14.11.2003. Suresh Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap passed on 21.06.2001. Prior to that Sugandhabai Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap passed away on 20.01.1977. Overall, except this applicants, no other legal heirs are in existence to deceased Manohar @ Mahadu. Applicants wanted the heirship certificate for the representing them as heirs of deceased Manohar @ Mahadu, Sugandhabai and Suresh. Lastly, prayed to allow the application.
3. Citation notice was issued on 23.02.2026. Paper publication was also issued in daily newspaper 'Punya Nagari' dated 26.02.2026 calling objections. No one has objected the claim of applicant.
4. In support of their contention, applicant No.1.1.2 has filed his evidence affidavit at Exh.9. To prove their case, applicants have also filed following documents on record :

Taking into consideration the material placed on record, it appears that Suresh Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap is the Class -I heir of Manohar @ Mahadu Vitthu Jagtap and Sugandhabai Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap. Further, the present applicants are the Class-I legal heirs of deceased Suresh Manohar @ Mahadu Jagtap as per Section 8 of Hindu Succession Act. It is pertinent to note that applicants are seeking plain heirship certificate because they have not mentioned any details of properties in the application. The learned advocate for the applicants submitted that, applicants be declared legal heirs of deceased Manohar @ Mahadu. Applicants will not claim upon any movable or immovable property belonging to deceased Manohar @ Mahadu. Therefore, I see no hurdle to issue plain heirship certificate in the name of applicants. Accordingly, following order.

: ORDER :

1. Application is allowed.
2. Applicant Nos.1.1.1 to 1.1.5 are hereby recognized as legal heirs of deceased **Manohar @ Mahadu Vitthu Jagtap**.
3. Issue heirship certificate in the name of applicant Nos.1.1.1 to 1.1.5 on payment of necessary court Fee.
4. This certificate should not be used to mutate their names in any movable or immovable property.
