Fresh charge sheet filed. It be checked and registered as per rules.

Present: Sh. Rohit Lohat, Ld. APP for the State.

IO HC Anil in person.

Accused in person with Ld. Remand counsel.

Complainant in person (identified by the IO).

Arguments heard. Charge sheet perused.

On the careful consideration of the chargesheet along with the annexing documents , including the statements recorded u/s 161 Crpc. I am of the considered opinion that prima facie offence u/s 411 IPC is made out as allegedly the accused was found in possession of snatched mobile phone.

Accordingly, I take cognizance of offence u/s 411 IPC.

Since the accused is present before the court today, formal summoning dispensed with.

Let the copy of the police report and corresponding documents be supplied to the accused person against receiving.

It is submitted by Ld. LADC that he has no objection if arguments on charge are heard today itself.

Arguments heard.

It is argued by Ld. counsel for the accused that accused person is innocent and deserves to be discharge.

Ld. APP has argued per-contra and has argued that charge u/s 411 IPC is made out.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

At the outset, it is relevant to mention that at the time of framing of charge, the court is not to go into whether the evidence on record would lead to conviction of the

accused persons but is merely to see whether *prima facie* case is made out against them or not. From the perusal of the entire record and after hearing the arguments, I am of the considered opinion that charge u/s 411 IPC is made out against the accused person.

Charge is separately framed. The same is read and explained to the accused person in vernacular language to which the accused person has pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Separate statement of accused recorded u/s 294 CrPC.

In view of the statement of the accused, witnesses mentioned at Serial No. 3 and 7 in the list of witnesses are dropped.

At this stage, PW/complainant has submitted that he is willing to settle the matter with the accused out of his own free will and volition for a compensation of Rs. 400/-. Compensation paid.

Statement of complainant has been recorded separately to this effect.

In view of the statement of the complainant, the offences U/s 411 IPC stand compounded as the parties have been permitted to compound the offences. **Thus, the accused Vishu Kumar, S/o Sh. Vijay Singh stands acquitted for offences U/s 411 IPC.**

Bail bonds are cancelled and surety is discharged. Superdarinama, if any, stands cancelled. Original documents/property, if any, be returned to the respective parties against receipt after verification and on cancellation of endorsement as per rules.

File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
