

Accused no.1 to 3 are not produced under body warrant.

Learned APP filed objections. Counsel for accused prays time for hearing.
Call on for hearing : 28-02-2019.

Reissue summons to Cw-8, 9, 15, 17.

Accused no.3 furnished surety to release him as per orders passed by the Hon'ble XI Addl. District and Sessions Judge Belagavi. Perused the records. Earlier this court was rejected the application filed by the accused no.3 U/Sec. 167(2) of Cr.P.C on 10-01-2018. The accused no.3 filed revision petition against the said order. The Hon'ble XI Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Belagavi allowed the said revision petition and set aside the order passed by this court on 10-01-2018. The Hon'ble XI Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Belagavi directed to release the accused no.3 on the following:

CONDITIONS

1. The accused no.3 shall execute bail bond for Rs.50,000/- with one solvent surety in each crime separately, to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
2. He shall not tamper prosecution witnesses.
3. He shall not leave India without the permission of the trial court.
4. He shall appear before the jurisdictional I.O once in every week and to sign the register till completion of investigation and filing charge sheet.

Surety by name Sri. Siddaramappa S/o. Tirakappa Divatar, Age:56 Yrs, Occ: Agriculture, R/o. Annigeri village, Dist: Dharwad is present and filed affidavit and application U/Sec.441(A) of Cr.P.C by stating ready to stand

as surety for accused no.3 and produced house property extract bearing T.P.C No.2310/D, situated at Annigeri village, Dist: Dharwad.

Perused the same, inquired and satisfied. Hence surety-ship to release the accused no.3 is accepted. Office is hereby directed to take bond.

Today body warrant of accused no.3 is not extended. Body warrant issued against accused no.3 is recalled. Issue intimation to jail authority in this regard.

Body warrant of accused no.1 and 2 is extended till 05-03-2019.
