

Accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 are present.

Sri. V.N.P advocate filed power on behalf of accused along with bail application.

ORDERS ON BAIL APPLICATION

U/Sec. 480 of BNSS

Accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 filed bail application by seeking bail and contended that they are innocent person and they are not committed any offence as alleged in the complaint, they are ready to furnish surety for their release and he is ready to obey all the terms and conditions laid down by the court while releasing them on bail. Per contra learned APP filed orally objection by contending alleged offence against the accused are non bailable in nature, there is chance of absconding of accused if they are released on bail.

Heard both sides and perused.

Points for my consideration on hearing is

1. Whether accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 are entitle to bail as they prayed ?
2. What Order ?

My opinion to the points for consideration.

1. Affirmative.
2. As per Order.

REASONS

The offences alleged against accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 punishable U/Sec.191(2)(3), 189(2), 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 329(3), 324(4), 352(2) R/w 190 of BNS . The said offence are non bailable in nature and triable by this court. The accused not required for investigation in the present case. He is not having any criminal background. Grievance of the learned APP may satisfied by imposing reasonable conditions. Hence, I pass the following;

ORDER

The bail application filed by the accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 hereby allowed with following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. The accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 shall execute bond of Rs. 50,000/- each for surety for like sum.
2. The accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 shall appear before this court on every hearing date.
3. The accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses.

Surety by name Shri. Bhujang S/o Parasharam Hadalagekar, Age:50 years, Occ. Agriculture, R/o. Hebbalhatti Village, Tq : Khanapur Dist: Belagavi, today at Khanapur is

present and filed affidavit, address proof document, declaration U/Sec. 486 of BNSS by submitting ready to stand as surety for accused and produced agricultural land bearing R.S.No. 37/2 totally measuring 02 acres 05 gunthas situated Habbal Village approximately valued for Rs. 20,00,000/- (Twenty Lakhs Rupees).

Perused the same and satisfied and his surety ship for release of accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10 accepted.

Office is hereby directed to take bond for sum of Rs. 50,000/- by Accused no. 1, 3, 7 to 10.
