

ORDER ON I.A.NO.I

The Plaintiff filed this application u/o 39 rule 1 and 2 r/w sec.151 of CPC seeking exparte T.I restraining the defendants, his agents, representatives etc., or any body acting on their behalf from alienating the suit property. In support of application on record plaintiff filed affidavit and stated that defendants are trying to alienate suit properties.

Heard Shri.ARAN, learned counsel of plaintiff. Pursued of records.

This is suit for Declaration and consequential relief of permanent injunction in respect of suit property and the plaintiff has produced the property extract, certificate issued by Gram panchayat and zerox copy of the sale deed and other documents. If defendants alienates the suit property then plaintiff would be put in great hardship and loss, so at this stage plaintiff made out case for granting exparte T.I. order otherwise very purpose of the suit will be defecated. Hence I proceed to pass the following

Order

Issue exparte T.I. restraining the defendants and anybody acting on their behalf from alienating suit property till next date.

The plaintiff shall comply the order as per order 39 Rule 3 CPC. Issue T.I. warrant and emergent notice on I.A I and suit summons to defendants returnable by 27-07-2017
