

ORDER ON IA No.I

The petitioner has filed this petition U/Sec.144 of B.N.S.S., and also filed application seeking interim order of maintenance of Rs.15,000/- per month against the respondent.

2. This Court has gone through the materials available on record.

3. It appears from the averments made in petition and other enclosures that the petitioner and the respondent are wife & husband. The petitioner has alleged that, the respondent has totally neglected the petitioner by not providing food, cloths, medicine and etc. Now the petitioner is residing separately. That the respondent is doing private job and getting salary of Rs.40,000/- and also having agricultural lands and getting income up to 5 to 6 lakhs per annum. Hence, the respondent is having sufficient source of income to maintain the petitioner.

4. Having regard to the object of interim application, interim orders may be passed. At this stage, it is not necessary to have a roving enquiry in respect of the allegations made against the respondent. All the contentious issues are left open for the trial. Hence, this court proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

The respondent is hereby directed to pay monthly maintenance of Rs.5,000/- (Five thousand only) to petitioner from the date of this petition until further orders by this Court.

Issue notice of petition and notice on interim orders to the respondent if steps are taken returnable by 09.06.2026.
