ORAL ORDER

This is an application for the grant of anticipatory bail under section 438 of the Cr.P.C., in connection with C.R. No. 982 of 2021, registered with Kurar Police Station, for the offences punishable

under sections 498-A, 406, 509 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2 Perused the application, the say filed thereon, the documents relied upon in support thereof.

3 Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned APP for the State.

4 It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that co-accused are on anticipatory bail. Per contra, it is submitted by the learned APP that stri-dhana has to be recovered, due to which, custodial interrogation is required.

5 As per the say filed by the police, the informant was subjected to cruelty. Her stri-dhana came to be misappropriated.

6 The nature of the offence is such that custodial interrogation is neither warranted, nor permissible for the recovery of stri-dhana articles. Hence, the applicant is entitled to anticipatory bail. Thus, I proceed to pass the following order :

ORDER

1) The application for the grant of anticipatory bail is hereby allowed and it is hereby directed that in the case of arrest of the applicant **Aravind Ramkishan Gupta**, in connection with C. R. No. 982 of 2021, registered with Kurar Police Station, for the offences punishable under sections 498-A, 406, 509 read with section 34 of

the Indian Penal Code, he be released on bail, on his executing PR Bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only), with one or more sureties in the like amount, on the conditions that he shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses in any manner and shall co-operate with the investigating agency.

2) The concerned Police Station be informed accordingly.

3) Anticipatory Bail Application No. 1846 of 2021 is hereby disposed of accordingly.
