Heard Shri. L.M.S. learned counsel for plaintiff.

Perused I.A.No.I, affidavit of the plaintiff, plaint and other documents available on record.

I.A.No.I is filed by the plaintiff U/Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C. seeking temporary injunction order restraining the defendant from alienating the suit property, till next date of hearing.

On going through the same, it appears that the present suit is for Permanent Injunction. Further, on perusal of the materials available on record, this Court is of the opinion that if an interim order of Temporary Injunction is not granted, the object of granting injunction would be defeated by delay. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

I.A.No.I filed by plaintiff U/Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w Sec.151 of C.P.C. is hereby **allowed**.

The defendant is hereby restrained from alienating the suit property, till next date of hearing.

Plaintiff is directed to comply Order 39 Rule 3(a) of C.P.C.

Issue suit summons, notice on I.A.No.I & T.I. warrant to defendant, if PF. paid R/by: 20-11-2024.
