CHIEF EXAMINATION BY :- LEARNED P.P.

I am working in VIMS, Ballari as a Casualty Medical Officer, since, 2020.

On 01.12.2021 at about 9.45 PM., patient by name Venkataswamy, aged about 48 years, Male came with history of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Masjid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, he is conscious and oriented sustained cut lacerated wound of 7 x 2 Cms over the left hand first web space with active bleeding.

I have given initial treatment in the form of dressing and I found that, the injury is grievous and severe hence, I referred patient to concerned specialist for further treatment.

I have also perused the X-ray report No.3229 dated: 01.12.2021 reported by Dr.Shadashiva Gouda. On perusing the X-ray I found that, there is a fracture of neck of first metacarpal of left hand.

Based on above wound description and X-ray, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injuries are grievous in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound certificate is marked as Ex.P.23 and signature is marked as Ex.P.23(a).

On the same day at about 9.52 PM., patient by name Smt.Saraswathi, aged about 38 years, Female came with history of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Masjid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, she is conscious and oriented sustained cut lacerated wound of 6 x 2 Cms over the right middle finger dorsal aspect. Based on the above wound and the X-ray report No.3230 dated: 01.12.2021 reported by Dr.Sadashiva Gouda, of X-ray right hand and chest shows no fracture.

Based on above wound description and X-ray, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injuries are simple in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound certificate is marked as Ex.P.24 and signature is marked as Ex.P.24(a).

On the same day at about 9.50 PM., patient by name Smt.Chandrakala, aged about 34 years, Female came with history

of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Maszid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, she is conscious and oriented sustained cut lacerated wound of 2 x 1 Cms over the right hand on palmar aspect with tenderness over the right hand. Based on the above wound and the X-ray report No.3231 dated: 01.12.2021 reported by Dr.Sadashiva Gouda, of X-ray right wrist with forearm shows no fracture.

Based on above wound description and X-ray, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injuries are simple in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound certificate is marked as Ex.P.25 and signature is marked as Ex.P.25(a).

On the same day at about 9.55 PM., patient by name Ajay, aged about 18 years, male came with history of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Maszid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, he is conscious and oriented sustained cut lacerated wound of 4 x 1 Cms over the right hand on palmar aspect with tenderness over the right wrist. Based on the above wound and the X-ray report No.3235 dated: 02.12.2021 reported by Dr.Sadashiva Gouda, of X-ray elbow right wrist with forearm shows no fracture.

Based on above wound description and X-ray, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injuries are simple in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound

certificate is marked as Ex.P.26 and signature is marked as Ex.P.26(a).

On the same day at about 9.57 PM., patient by name Vijay Kumar, aged about 16 years, male came with history of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Maszid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, he is conscious and oriented sustained cut lacerated wound of 2 x 1 Cms over the top of the nose. X-ray report not available.

Based on above wound description, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injury is simple in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound certificate is marked as Ex.P.27 and signature is marked as Ex.P.27(a).

On the same day at about 10.00 PM., patient by name A.K.Adinarayana, aged about 16 years, male came with history of assault at around 7.50 PM., near Maszid, Millerpet, Ballari. I have examined the patient, it appears that, he is conscious and oriented sustained injury and tenderness over the left hand.

Based on above wound description, I am of the opinion that, above mentioned injury is simple in nature. To that effect I have issued wound certificate on 15.12.2021. Witness identified the wound certificate and his signature. Wound certificate is marked as Ex.P.28 and signature is marked as Ex.P.28(a).

Based on the appearance of the wound and the above mentioned patients injuries are fresh in nature.

On 31.12.2021 I have examined M.O.1 and 2 submitted by Sharmas, H.C. 347 of Brucepet Police Station, Ballari. The injuries mentioned in Ex.P.23 to 28 can be caused by weapons like M.O.1 and 2. To that effect I have issued report and identified by the witness and same is marked as Ex.P.29 and signature is marked as Ex.P.29(a).

Cross Examination by Sri. BVB., advocate.

It is true to suggest that, in a casualty ward I have to examine the patient and refer to the concerned department for the treatment. It is true to suggest that, after referring the patient the concerned department doctor has to give treatment to the patient and if any needful he has to refer the necessary investigation and do the treatment. It is false to suggest that, I have not referred any injured for X-ray. It is true to suggest that, I have not sent the written requisition to the X-ray department for X-ray of the above said injured persons. It is true to suggest that, I have not mentioned the X-ray reference of the above said injured persons in the Ex.P.23 to 28 and also in MLC register. It is false to suggest that, I have not received any X-ray report from the Dr.Sadashiva Gouda for the above named injured persons. It is false to suggest that, CW.1 has not sustained any fracture and grievous injuries as mentioned in Ex.P.23.

It is true to suggest that, the incised wound can be caused clean cut sharp edged weapon. It is false to suggest that, the lacerated wound can caused irregular edge of the weapon. It is false to suggest that, M.O,1 and 2 are not caused any cut lacerated

wound. It is true to suggest that, I have not mentioned the depth of the injury in Ex.P.23 to 28. It is false to suggest that, I have not examined above named any injured and none of the above named persons have not sustained any injuries. It is false to suggest that, I have issued false certificate the police and the higher revenue authority.

I do not know who were present on that day but some Government officials were present in the hospital. It is true to suggest that, I have not mentioned the requisition letter number in Ex.P.29. It is true to suggest that, there is no any endorsement to receipt of M.O.1 and 2 and after examination there is no any acknowledgement of the same. It is false to suggest that, I have not examined M.O.1 and 2 and gave false report as per Ex.P.29 to oblige the police and revenue authority.
