Present application moved on behalf of accused Sarita Choudhary for issuance of No Objection Certificate for passport is taken up for hearing.

Present: Ld. APP for the State.

Applicant/accused person with Ld. Counsel Mr. Vipin Chaudhary.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused that no objection be issued to the applicant/accused for issuance of passport.

Heard. Perused.

The notification of the Government of India dated 25.08.1993 issued by the Ministry of External Affairs provides, inter alia, that for the issuance of the passport of citizens against whom criminal proceedings are pending, an order from court is required granting “No Objection” for issuance of the passport. Thus, a “no objection” is a requirement of procedure for the issuance of the passport of the person against whom a criminal case is pending.

In view of the said notification and considering the totality of circumstances the application for issuance of No Objection Certificate for applying for fresh passport stands allowed for ten years along with permission to travel abroad subject to the condition that the applicant/accused person shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.
