1. Now I have seen the summary sheet, discharge summary and other medical records of Thippeswamy. All these records are together marked as Ex.P.17 and signature of witness on discharge summary is marked as Ex.P.17(a).

Cross Examination by Sri.BVB advocate for accused No.1 to 3, 6 and 7:-

2. It is true to suggest that on overall perusal of Ex.P.17 medical records of Thippeswamy, they reveal that he sustained injuries while extinguishing fire on his wife, in order to save her. It is true to suggest that it is not mentioned in casualty medical records of Thippeswamy that quarrel took place between husband and wife. Casualty medical record will be the first medical record. It is not true to suggest that Thippeswamy has sustained burn injuries to the extent of 15%. It is true to suggest that in the history sheet

attached to Ex.P.17, it is written that he sustained 10-15% second degree superficial to deep burn over both hands.
