CHIEF EXAMINATION BY :- LEARNED P.P.

From 2004, I am working as Medical Officer, VIMS Hospital (Now, changed as BMCRC), Ballari.

2. On 26.06.2019 at 8.10 pm patient by name Gadilingappa came to our hospital with the history of assault. I examined him. On examination, the following wounds were found:

- 1) Cut lacerated wound measuring 4 X 1 cm on left parietal region.
- 2) Cut lacerated wound measuring 4 X 1 cm on frontal region.
- 3) Swelling of left fore arm.
- 4) Swelling of right wrist.

X-ray of the patient was taken and noticed that Injury No.03 and 4 are grievous in nature. Injury No.01 and 2 are simple in nature.

3. Accordingly, I issued injury certificate. Now, I have seen injury certificate and it is marked as Ex.P-5 and signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P-5(a).

4. On the same day, injured by name Gangamma came to our hospital with the history of assault at 8.10 pm. I examined her. On examination, the following wounds were found:-

- 1) Cut lacerated wound measuring 4 X 1 cm on Fronto parietal region. The said injury was fresh in nature.
- 2) Cut lacerated wound measuring 4 X 1 cm on occipital region.

X-ray/CT Scan of the patient was taken and noticed that there were no fractures. Injury No.01 and 2 are simple in nature.

5. Accordingly, I issued injury certificate. Now, I have seen injury certificate and it is marked as Ex.P-6 and signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P-6(a).

6. On the same day, injured by name Mariswamy came to our hospital with the history of assault at 8.20 pm. I examined him. On examination, the following wounds were found:-

- 1) Cut lacerated wound measuring 5 X 1 cm on Right Occipital region.
- 2) Two abrasions measuring 1 X 1 cm on both knees.

X-ray/CT Scan of the patient was taken and noticed that there were no fractures. Injury No.01 and 2 are simple in nature.

7. Accordingly, I issued injury certificate. Now, I have seen injury certificate and it is marked as Ex.P-7 and signature of the witness is marked as Ex.P-7(a).

8. If, persons are assaulted with sticks like M.O-1 and 2, the injuries mentioned in Ex.P-5 to 7 can be caused.

Cross examination by Sri.Shekanna LADC:

9. It is true to suggest that, we will enter MLC Register regarding the persons come to our hospital with history of assault. It is true to suggest that, we will intimate the police immediately whenever the case is entered in MLC Register.

10. I have not produced any documents to show that I have issued MLC intimation to concerned police. I have not produced X-ray report of Gadilingappa before the Court.

11. I have not produced X-ray/CT Scan reports of Gangamma and Mariswamy before the Court. We take around 5-10 minutes for examination of each patients. It is true to suggest that, I cannot examine two patients simultaneously.

12. I have not mentioned age of the injures in Ex.P-5 and 7 Wound certificate. It is true to suggest that, if any person falls from bullcort on hard surface, injuries mentioned in Ex.P-5 to 7 may be caused. It is not true to suggest that, I have issued false wound certificate just to help the police.

13. It is not true to suggest that, I have not at all examined any of the patients as stated above. It is not true to suggest that, I have given false wound certificate and giving false evidence.

Sri.HV advocate submits that he will adopt the cross examination made by Sri.Shekanna LADC.
