

ORDER ON IA.II

Heard arguments. Perused plaint averments. Plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of permanent injunction and also filed I.A.No.II U/O.39 Rule 1 and 2 R/w. Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure seeking relief of ad-interim temporary injunction against defendants No.1 to 4 restraining them from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the plaintiff over suit schedule property till disposal of suit.

Considering the nature of suit and documents filed along with the plaint, I am of the opinion that ordering of notice to the opponents would delay the proceedings and results in multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, preserving the said property in the same status is necessary. Otherwise, the case of the plaintiffs would be frustrated and if notice is ordered, the very purpose of I.A. will be defeated and plaintiff will be put to great hardship and injury. Hence, I proceed to pass following :-

ORDER

Issue order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants No.1 to 4 from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the plaintiff over suit schedule property till next hearing date.

Plaintiff to comply Order 39 Rule 3(a). If compliance is reported, issue emergent notice of I.A.No.II and suit summons to defendants.
