1. Whether the Plaintiffs prove that the suit schedule properties are ancestral and joint family properties of themselves and defendant No.1 to 4 and are available for partition?
2. Whether the Plaintiffs further prove that the registered sale deed dated 14-06-2018 executed by deceased Eranagappa in favor of defendant No.5 with respect to suit item No.2 and 3 properties and the registered sale deed dated 27/09/2021 executed by the defendant No.1 to 4 in favor of defendant No.6 with respect to suit item No. 1 properties are null and void?
3. Whether the Defendant Nos.1 to 4 prove that the suit property item No. 1 and 3 are self acquired properties of deceased Eranagappa and suit item No.1 to 3 properties were sold for their family legal

necessities as contended in para (e) and (f) of the written statement?

4. Whether the defendant No.5 proves that the suit item No.2 and 3 properties were sold for legal necessities of the family of plaintiffs and defendant No.1 to 4 and thereby he is the bonafide purchaser of suit item No.2 and 3 properties?
5. Whether the defendant No.6 proves that the suit item No.1 property was sold for legal necessities of the family of plaintiffs and defendant No.1 to 4 and thereby she is the bonafide purchaser of suit item No.1 property?
6. Whether the Plaintiffs are entitled for the relief as sought for?
7. What Order or Decree?
