Sri. BHG files vakalath for defendant. Both the counsels file joint memo to refer the matter to Lok Adalath. As the suit is for partition between family members this suit is referred to Lok Adalath.

Plaintiff and defendant were present through video call made from Watsapp application.

Counsel for plaintiff and defendant were present before the Lok Adalath. Non Judicial Conciliator was also present. Plaintiff and defendant were present through video call. Before conciliating the parties I have called each person and verified there names and they have also shown their Aadhar card to me over video call. Being satisfied that the parties present in the video call are the plaintiff and defendant I have

proceeded to conciliate the parties.

Both the parties were conciliated in the presence of their counsels over video call. All the parties have agreed to settle their disputes and agreed to compromise the matter. Later the counsels have produce compromise petition u/o 23 rule 3 of CPC along with copies of Aadhar Cards of the parties.

I have enquired the parties over video call whether they know the contents of compromise petition and whether they have voluntarily compromised the matter. I have read over the contents of compromise petition. The parties have stated that they have voluntarily compromised the matter in order to put an end to the litigation and to safe guard their relationship. They have also admitted the contents of compromise petition.

I have perused the compromise petition. The compromise as well as the terms of compromise petition are not against any law. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following...

ORDER

Compromise petition filed u/o
XXIII rule 3 of CPC is hereby allowed.

Suit of the plaintiff is hereby
decreed in terms of compromise
petition.

Draw final decree accordingly.
