

Case called out before the National Lok Adalat.

Accused wants to plead guilty. Consequences of pleading guilty explained to him. Despite knowing the consequences, he wants to plead guilty. Hence For plea and plea of accused is recorded for the offence punishable under Sections Sections 4(1) and (3) and Rules 3 of Karnataka Shop and Commercial Establishment Act-1961 and Rules-1963. Accused admitted the guilt. Admission appears to be voluntary.

Hence plea is accepted. The accused voluntarily submitted that he is the only earning member of his family and prayed for lenient view in imposing fine.

Considering the age and avocation of accused, as well as the circumstances for having committed the alleged offence, I am of the considered opinion that, it is the fit case to impose lesser punishment. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following.

**ORDER**

Acting under Sec.275 of B.N.S.S accused is hereby convicted of the offence punishable under Sections 4(1) and (3) and Rules 3 of Karnataka Shop and Commercial Establishment Act-1961 and Rules-1963. He is sentenced to pay fine of

Rs.1,000/- In default, she shall undergo S.I. for a period of 15 days.

Office is hereby directed to collect the aforesaid fine amount and close the case accordingly.
