ORDER

Vide this order, I intend to dispose of bail application under
Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by applicant-accused Rohit Singh alias Limca in
the FIR mentioned above.

Lower Court record was summoned and received.

Learned Counsel for the applicant-accused argued that

applicant-accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. No overt act has been attributed to applicant-accused. He is in custody since long. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant-accused. The completion of trial will take long time and prayed that bail application be allowed.

On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for the State opposed the bail application and argued that serious allegations have been leveled against applicant-accused that he alongwith co-accused came outside the house of Paramjit Singh and Angrej Singh fired with his pistol. It is not a fit case, where concession of bail can be given to accused and prayed that bail application be dismissed.

The present case was registered at the instance of Paramjit Singh, on the allegations that on 08.04.2019, at about 1:40 PM, he heard a noise of abusing coming from the street. He saw towards street from terrace of his house and noticed that Angrej Singh and one boy were were sitting on pulsar motorcycle and were abusing by calling his name. Angrej Singh was sitting on back seat of motorcycle and was holding a pistol and on seeing him, Angrej Singh, with an intention to kill, fired at him and he saved himself by sitting down. Angrej Singh again fired 2/3 shots from pistol. He raised raula and both of them drove away the motorcycle while giving threats.

Serious allegations have been leveled against the applicant-accused that he was present with co-accused Angrej Singh, who fired at complainant. So, keeping in view of the gravity of offence alleged to have been committed by the applicant-accused, applicant-accused is found not entitled to the concession of bail as he will try to tamper with the prosecution evidence. So, bail application is ordered to be dismissed. Lower Court record alongwith copy of this order be returned forthwith. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
