Report of Ahlmad with regard to pendency/decision of bail application of accused has been called and as per report, no such bail application is pending or decided. In this regard, statement of ASI Rajinder Singh has also been recorded.

2. Heard on bail application filed on behalf of accused Nachattar Singh @ Giani.

3. Brief facts of the present case are that the present FIR was registered on the statement of Gurjant Singh son of Sardara Singh on the ground that the accused persons committed theft of equipments from transformers. Accused was apprehended.

4. Learned counsel for the accused argued that accused person has been falsely implicated in the present case and he is innocent. He further argued that the prosecution allegations are false and concocted. He further argued that nothing remains to be recovered from the applicant/accused. Thus, he prayed that the present application be allowed.

5. On the other hand, learned APP for the State argued that offence against the accused are serious one and no ground is made out to grant him bail. Thus, he prayed that the present application be dismissed.

6. After hearing the contentions of the learned counsel for the applicants/ accused and learned APP for the State and going through the case file, I am of the view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused Nachattar Singh @ Giani in custody for indefinite period. Thus, the present bail application of the accused person Nachattar Singh @ Giani under Section 303(2)/238/317(2) of BNS is allowed subject to furnishing the bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- in the like amount. Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. Intimation be sent to the accused with regard to his bail application

through Jail Superintendent, Sri Muktsar Sahib. Papers are ordered to be attached with remand papers.
