4. Whether defendant No.6 to 10 prove that, suit of plaintiffs is hit by the principles of Res-Judicata?
5. Whether defendant No.6 to 10 prove that, suit of plaintiffs is barred by law of limitation?
6. Whether defendant No.6 to 10 prove that, suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?
7. Whether defendant No.6 to 10 prove that, this court has no pecuniary jurisdiction to entertain the suit?
