

**BEFORE THE NATIONAL LOK-
ADALATH DATED 14.03.2026.**

Case called out before the Lok Adalath.

The complainant's Cashier/PW.2 and counsel Sri.SMH for Sri.VTK present.

The accused and his counsel Sri.AMZ present.

The complainant & accused have jointly filed an application U/Sec.147 of NI Act stating that, as the complainant received the settlement amount from the accused, the complainant doesn't want to proceed with the case. Hence the case may be disposed off accordingly.

Perused the application and all other materials on record.

The contents of application are read over & explained to the complainant & accused, for which they voluntarily admitted the same.

As per the materials on record, the complainant has filed this complaint U/Sec.200 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to punish the accused for the offence punishable U/Sec.138 of NI Act.

As per the contents of application, the complainant and the accused have got compounded the offence. As the offence alleged against accused is compoundable in nature, there is no legal impediment to allow the complainant to compound the offence. Accordingly we proceed to pass the following;

ORDER

An application filed U/Sec.147 of NI Act jointly by the complainant and accused is hereby allowed.

Consequently the accused is acquitted of the offence punishable U/Sec.138 of NI Act.

Accordingly, the case is disposed off.
