ORDER ON IA.NO.I

The applicant, Shri.Hanamant Kuri has filed this application under Order III Rule 2(a) R/w Section 151 of CPC seeking permission to conduct and prosecute this case through his General Power of Attorney by name Shri.Bhimappa S/o Hanamant Kuri as power of attorney holder in this case, in the interest of justice and equity.

2. In the accompanying affidavit to the interim application, the applicant has stated that, the plaintiff Bhimappa S/o Hanamant Kuri is his father and he is suffering from old age ailments and unable to attend each and every date of hearing of this case and he has executed a General Power of Attorney dated 30-01-2026 authorizing him to participate in the proceedings. Hence, he has prayed to allow the application.

3. The defendants have not filed objections to the application.

4. Heard the counsel appearing for the plaintiff and perused the materials on record.

5. Upon perusal of the accompanying affidavit of the interim application, the plaintiff has shown proper reasons in support of his request. Along with this application, he has produced the General Power of Attorney, which suffices to show that the plaintiff had executed the GPA in favour of his son.

Order III rule 2 of CPC provides provision regarding appointment agents of the parties.

2. Recognized agents – *The recognized agents of parties by whom such appearances, applications and acts may be made or done are –*

(a) person holding power-of-attorney, authorizing them to make and do such appearances, applications and acts on behalf of such parties:

(b) persons carrying on trade or business for and in the names of parties not resident within the local limits of the jurisdiction of the court within which limits the appearance, application or act is made or done, in matters connected with such trade or business only, where no other agent is expressly authorized to make and do such appearances, applications and acts.

6. The aforesaid provision empowers this court to consider the application filed by the plaintiff. Therefore, in

order to determine the rights and liabilities of the parties and to avoid multiplicity of proceedings, this application is allowed. No harm or prejudice would be caused to the other side. Hence, for the reasons stated above and in the interest of justice, this court proceed to pass the following:

: ORDER :

I.A. No.I filed by the applicant under Order III Rule 2(a) R/w 151 of CPC is hereby allowed.

The applicant is permitted to prosecute the suit through his GPA holder by name Shri.Bhimappa S/o Hanamant Kuri.
