CHIEF EXAMINATION BY P.P :

From 14-12-2016 to till this date I have been working as police inspector in Bangalore crime branch. The ACP of CCB orally directed me to arrest accused by name Dore Raju alias Raj Dore who involved in many cognizable offences with in the limits of various police station. Accordingly, myself and my staff CW2 to 6 were attempting to arrest the accused. On 21-10-2017 I received credible information of the presence of accused at petrol bunk located on 8th mile, Tumkur Road at 6.30am. Accordingly, myself, my staff went to the said place in Government jeep bearing number KA-02-G-1121. When we reached said place we found one person was standing along with two wheeler vehicle. When we reach to him very nearer to the said person, on seeing us he tried to escape in his two wheeler vehicle and proceeded on Hesaragatta Road. We followed his vehicle in our jeep and giving caution to him to stop his vehicle but he did not stop, when he reached at Acharya institute he was about to reach eucalyptus forest area.

We chased him and in order to stop him we slightly dashed to his two wheeler vehicle. As a result of it the two wheeler vehicle of accused fell down he started to run to escape. We also chased him while we were in the process of chasing, the accused took long chopper which was kept inside his cloth on his back and tried to attack us. At that time we also warned him to surrender and not to make such attempt. He did not stop from his attack and to bring down the situation in to normal I fired to the air from my service revolver. Even inspite of it he did not stop his act. At that time my staff CW3 Narasimhamurthy tried to catch him, the accused attacked him with long chopper and tried to cause injury but it was caused injuries to his left hand. In order to avoid further complication I fired to his right leg and as a result of it he fell down. Immediately the inspector Manjunath and his staff shifted the accused and CW3 to the nearest hospital i.e., Sapthagiri Hospital in our vehicle. Thereafter I gave intimation to the area inspector as well as to the control room and also to the superior officers. Accordingly I lodged complaint against accused. When he fell down I enquired his name and confirmed that he is the person by name Raj Dore to whom we were searching. The witness identified his signature in the complaint it is marked as Ex P1, signature is marked as Ex P1 (a). After lodging of the complaint I visited spot along with investigation officer and panchas. The investigation officer prepared the mahazar in between 10.00am to 12.30 after noon and seized the bike of accused bearing number KA-03-JM-9533, one helmet, one footrest, two empty catrages, long chopper used to attack and his slippers. The I.O collected blood stained mud and sample mud and also two live catrages and service pistol and signed the mahazar. Now I see

the mahazar it is marked as Ex P2, signature is marked as Ex P2 (a). I noticed blood stains on the long chopper. Now I see the photographs taken on the spot which are 14 in number and it is marked as Ex P3 to P16. Sealed bags are opened. Now I see one pair slippers, helmet and footrest of two wheeler vehicle, empty catrages, long chopper, blood stained mud, normal mud, two live bullets, service pistol it is marked as Mo1 to 9. The said person is before the court. The accused has caused obstruction to our duty and attempt to murder us.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY RKR FOR ACCUSED :

At this stage in view of application filed U/s 231 C of CrPC pending disposal of said application cross examination is deferred.
