Examination-in-chief: By PP:

From March 2011 till September 2016 I was working as Incharge Assistant Director in Biology Section, F.S.L, Bangalore.

On 05.05.2014 our office had received twelve sealed articles pertaining to Cr. No.36/14 of Dabaspete police station through P.C.No.841 for chemical analysis and report.

The said twelve sealed articles were intact and were tallying with the sample seal. Twelve articles were taken for chemical examination.

The first article was a blood stain mud, second one sample mud, third one was cloth piece, fourth one jurkin, fifth one plant branch, sixth – one shirt, seventh- one pant, eighth- one under wear, ninth to eleventh –three cutters, twelfth - one iron rod. I subjected these articles for chemical analysis. Blood stain was detected in article No.1 , 3 to 9 , 11 and 12. Blood stain was not detected in article No.2 and 10. these blood stains were further subjected to serological analysis and they were stained with human blood belonging to “O” group. Accordingly I issued report. The witness identifies the said report and his signature therein. It is marked as Ex.P29 and signature as Ex.P29(a). The said report was forwarded by the Director of F.S.L to the I.O. Sample seal is Ex.P30. After examination all articles were repacked, resealed and sent back to concerned police. Now I see the articles they are already marked as M.o-1 to 12.
