Report from the Probation Officer received stating that the convict Lakshay has suffered memory loss due to a head injury and now he is focusing on doing better in life.

Argument on point of sentence heard.

Considering that the convict is living a stable purposeful and peaceful life, he is granted benefit of section 4 of the Probation and Offenders Act. Convict is directed to furnish a bond with one surety of like amount in the sum of RS. 50,000/-.

In view of the request made by the convict, bail bonds furnished on 22.01.2025 are extended for the purpose of probation. The complainant Pintu Singh has already expired during the trial and therefore, no compensation is awarded to him. Considering the medical condition of the convict, he is directed to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- in the account of Distt Court Employees Welfare Association. Compensation amount has been paid. The convict is directed to maintained the peace and good behaviour for a period of 3 years from today and in case any offence is committed by the convict, the benefit of Probation shall be withdrawn and file shall be revived for appropriate orders on sentence.
