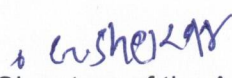

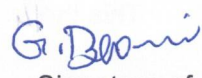

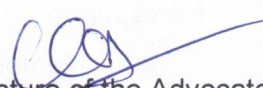
AWARD

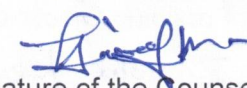

The claim under Dishonored Cheque amount settled for Rs 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only). Accused agreed to pay or paid the settled amount to the complainant towards full and final settlement of the cheque amount. The Complainant has received the said settled amount from the Accused towards full satisfaction of the dishonored cheque amount. So, accordingly, the accused is acquitted U/sec. 320(8) Cr.P.C for the offence punishable U/sec 138 of Negotiable Instrument act. 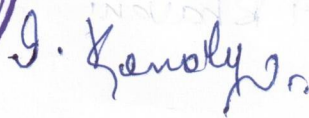
