2. On examination the injured Bhagyamma, I found, i) contusion mark 5 x 6 cm, one in number, over lateral aspect of left thigh, no swelling and no restriction of movement, ii) Contusion mark 2 x 3 cm size, one in number on lateral aspect of left lower leg, no swelling or restriction of

movement. In my opinion the above injuries are simple in nature. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now marked at Ex.P.4 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.4(a).

3. On examination the injured Radha I found, I) contusion mark 4 x 3 cm, one in number, over lateral aspect of right thigh, no swelling and no restriction of movement, ii) small abrasion below left knee. In my opinion the above injuries are simple in nature. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now marked at Ex.P.5 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.5(a).

4. On examination the injured Prema, I found, I) abrasion mark over left wrist, no swelling or restriction of movement, ii) Contusion mark 2 x 3 cm, one in number over medial aspect of left leg above ankle joint, no swelling and no restriction of movement. In my opinion the above injuries are simple in nature. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now

marked at Ex.P.6 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.6(a).

5. The injuries mentioned in Ex.P. 4 to 6 are probable in case of assault with M.O. 1 and 2 sticks.

Cross examination: By Sri. PDT for accused.

6. Injured persons were not accompanied with any other persons to the Hospital. The name of assailants, place of assault and age of the injuries are not mentioned in Ex.P.4 to 6. I can not tell how old the injuries are. OPD number or admission number is not mentioned in Ex.P.4 to 6. If the injured persons come to Hospital after registering the case in Police Station, the crime number is mentioned in the wound certificate.

7. Normally an entry is made in MLC register. But MLC number is not mentioned in Ex.P.4 to 6. Witness volunteers to state that, in this case MLC entry is made in this also. MLC register copy is not given to the Investigating officer in this case.

8. On 02.10.2020 DySP, Doddaballapura Sub Division has given requisition to me to issue wound certificates. Investigating office had sent M.O. 1 and 2 to seek opinion whether the injuries mentioned in Ex.P.4 to 6 are probable in case of assault with M.O.1 and 2. I have also given opinion to investigating officer in that regard. Investigating officer had sent two sticks to seek my opinion. When it is asked to the witness that in case of assault with stick, there would be swelling on the body, the witness replies that such swelling on the body may or may not happen in case of assault with stick.

9. Contusion and abrasion injuries are probable in case of fall or contact on hard surface with force. It is false to say that though I have not examined and treated the injured persons, I have issued false wound certificate as per Ex.P.4 to 6 at the instance of Police and deposing falsely. It is false to say that since Ex.P.4 to 6 are false wound certificates, I have not mentioned OPD number therein. It is false to say that I am stating for the first time that the assault took place near Jonnahalli Chikkanna field by Rajanna.
