CHIEF EXAMINATION : BY SPECIAL PP

From 2011 to 2017 I served as Visiting orthopedic Surgeon in Siddalingappa Memorial Hospital, Konanakunte Cross, Bengaluru. On 02.09.2012 at 05.30 p.m. injured person by name Deepak, came to Siddalingappa Memorial Hospital with history of assault on same day near Thalaghappura. The injured was accompanied by one Asha. The history was given by the injured. On examination I found that, i) left fronto temporal pre-maxillary and pre-septal extra cranial soft tissue contusion, ii) fracture to lateral wall of left orbit, iii) blunt injury to nose.

2. The injured was treated as out patient. In my opinion the above injury no.1 and 3 are simple in nature and injury no.2 is grievous injury. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now marked at Ex.P.7 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.7(a). Injuries caused to injured person is probable in case of assault by fist with force.

Cross examination: Sri. BNA for accused no.3 and 4

3. Name of the assailants were not disclosed by injured person before me. The injuries shown in the wound certificate are also probable in case of fall on hard surface. I noticed no injuries caused with human nails on injured person.

Re-examination: Nil
