CHIEF EXAMINATION : BY SPECIAL PP

Since 2015 I am serving as Consultant Assistant Surgeon in Ramakrishna Hospital, Jayanagar, Bengaluru.

2. On 24.07.2016 at 10.30 p.m. injured person by name Krishna was brought by one Lohith to our Hospital with history of assault on same day at 11.30 a.m. The history was given by the injured.

3. On examination Krishna, I found that he sustained i) scalp contusion over occiput, ii) right black eye, iii) non concussive head injury.

4. The injured was treated as in-patient and was discharged on 25.07.2016. In my opinion the above injuries are simple in nature. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now marked at Ex.P.3 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.3(a).

5. On same day at 10.25 p.m. injured person by name Munibyrappa was brought by one Lohith to our Hospital with history of assault on same day at 11.30 a.m. The history was given by the injured.

6. On examination Krishna, I found that he sustained i) abrasion 2 x 2cm right side frontal area, ii) non concussive head injury.

7. The injured was treated as in-patient and was discharged on 25.07.2016. In my opinion the above injuries are simple in nature. The document now shown to me is the wound certificate issued by me pertaining to said injured and it bears my signature. The injury certificate is now marked at Ex.P.4 and the signature of the witness is marked at Ex.4(a).

8. The scalp, abrasion and head injuries caused to injured persons are probable in case of assault with wooden club. Black eye may be caused in case of assault with fisting.

Cross examination: By Sri. SP for accused no.1 to 3 and 5.

9. The names of assailants are not disclosed in both wound certificates. The name of weapon used for the assault is not disclosed in wound certificates. The wounds were not fresh but 11 hours old.

10. If a person skids from motor bike, the injuries sustained in Ex.P.3 wound certificate may be caused. If a person is drunk and falls on hard surface, injuries mentioned in Ex.P.4 wound certificate may be caused. It is false to say that though I have not examined and treated both persons, I have issued false wound certificates and deposing falsely at the instance of the Police.

Cross examination: By Smt. SP for accused no.4
