EXAMINATION-IN-CHIEF BY LEARNED P.P:

I am working as Professor, Department of Forensic Medicine at Bengaluru Medical College Research Institute, Bengaluru since last 05 years and various capacities since 2000. I received requisition from Byadarahalli Police Station on 19.02.2020 at 10.15 AM to conduct PM of Prasanna Kumar, aged about 37 years.

2. Cloths and articles found over the body:

i. On examination of the dead body that of 37 years old male and found black colour hoodi jacket with zipper down the front with labeled read as “KRRISH” and tear at the right armpit and dried vegetation and soil particles present at places.

ii. Pink and white coloured full sleeved cotton shirt with checkered pattern and labeled read as “FLYING MACHINE” large.

iii. Grayish green coloured pant with labeled read as “DOUBLE HORSE” and dried vegetation and soil particles present at places.

3. Dead body is that of a wheatish complexioned male measuring 176 cm in length, well build and moderately nourished. Body is cold and stiff, post mortem staining present over front of chest and face and in patches over back of the body. Blood seen oozing from left ear. Tip of the

tongue is bitten. Postmortem antbite marks present at places over the body. Dried vegetation and soil particles present over the face, mouth and upper limbs.

4. I noted totally 20 external injuries and mentioned in detail in PM report.

5. I noted the following internal injuries on dissection.

1. ON reflection of scalp there is blood extravasation over the right fronto-temporal region over an area measuring 11cmx5cm with contusion of right temporalis muscle.

6. Skull vertebra and membrane intact. Brain-patches of subarachnoid hemorrhage present over the frontal, temporal and parital lobes on both sides of varying sizes measuring 2cmx2cm to 6cmx5cm. Edemartous c/s areas of softening seen.

7. Blood extravasation seen into the plurae and chest wall muscles on right side adjacent to 5-10 ribs.

8. Heart and lungs congested. Stomach contain above 100 ml of greenish yellow fluid no unusual smell, mucosa appears normal. All other organs are intact.

9. injuries are antemortem in nature and fresh. Abrasions are bright red in colour and fresh. Contusions are red in colour and further exploration there is blood extravasation in to the subcutaneous layer and muscles plane.

10. After examination the cloths are packed separately, labelled, sealed and handed over to the concerned police with sample seal.

11. Opinion as to the cause of Death is- Death is due to shock and hemorrhage as a result of multiple contusions consequent to blunt trauma sustained. Accordingly I have issued PM report. Now I have seen the PM report and it is marked as Ex.P.22 and witness signature is marked as Ex.P.22(a). The injuries mentioned in the PM report could

be caused when assaulted with the type of wooden logs or clubs. The said wooden logs produced before the court with a sealed cover and after permission of the court which are opened and shown to the witness. The witness admitted by using wooden logs as shown me could be caused the injuries and said wooden logs now marked as M.O.1 to 3.

12. Black colour hoodi jacket with labeled read as "KRRISH". Pink and white coloured full sleeved cotton shirt and Greyish green coloured pant produced before the court with a sealed cover and after permission of the court which are opened and shown to the witness. The witness admitted the above cloths were handed over to the police at the time of PM. These cloths are marked as M.O.4 to 6.

CROSS EXAMINATION ON BEHALF OF ACCUSED BY SRI.HT ADVOCATE:

13. It is false to suggest that I have issued Ex.P.22 PM report on request of police without conducting autopsy. It is

false to suggest that without examination of weapons I could not give opinion that by using M.O.1 to 3, the injuries mentioned in Ex.P.22 could be caused. It is true to suggest that in which weapon used for assault could be caused which number of injuries. It is true that to assault by some other wooden logs the injuries could be caused.
