EXAMINATION-IN-CHIEF BY LEARNED PP:

About 4 years prior to my deposition in the morning hours I have put my signature to panch notice and panchanama now shown to me at Byadrahalli Police Station. Said panch notice is marked as Ex.P.3 and my signature on it is marked as Ex.P.3(a). Said panchanama is already marked as Ex.P.2 and my signature on it is

marked as Ex.P.2(b). I do not know why my signatures are taken to these documents. I do not know the contents of Ex.P.2 and 3. Police have not taken me to any place. I do not know whether any other persons were there at that time.

CROSS-EXAMINATION BY LEARNED PP:

2. I do not remember that I was called to Byadrahalli Police Station on 18.01.2021. It is false to suggest that at that time CW.1 and 7 were in the Police Station. It is false to suggest that CW.1 has taken me, CW.7 and Police to the spot of incident i.e., to the cellar of B.S Max Apartment at Bilekallu Road. I do not know that the articles in that shop were scattered, the cash counting machine was damaged and the cash counter was empty and CCTV camera installed to said shop was damaged. I do not know that panchanama was drawn

from 9.00 am to 10.00 am in that shop of CW.1. It is false to suggest that I was present at that time and panchanama was drawn in my presence and after it was read over to me, I put my signature in that spot only. It is false to suggest that I became afraid of accused persons and hence I am deposing falsely.
