

ORDERS

The matter is advanced on the application filed by Sri. V.P.S the counsel for the petitioner. Further, the petitioner has filed I.A U/s.151 of CPC., for issuing exemption letter directing the Sub-Registrar, Kanakapura to register the final decree.

2. In support of the application, the petitioner has sworn her affidavit, wherein she states that after obtaining the copy of the final decree, the revenue authorities have directed to register the same before the Sub-Registrar. Thereafter, the petitioner has produced the final decree before the Sub-Registrar, Anekal for its registration, but, the Sub-Registrar, Anekal refused to register the same, the reason well known to themselves. Now, the petitioner has filed the present petition for issuing of exemption letter directing the Sub-Registrar, Kanakapura to register the final decree.

3. In this case, the respondents have not appeared before the court in final decree proceedings. After hearing the matter and on perusal of the case papers, this court already issued final decree as per the terms of the preliminary decree. The duty of the court is, issue the final decree after furnishing the necessary stamp paper. Thereafter, it is the duty of the parties to register the same before the competent forum. On
