Reply filed by Addl. DCP, as per which, operation of similar orders seeking fate of departmental proceedings has been set aside by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. Accordingly, it is prayed that previous order seeking fate of disciplinary proceedings "be dropped".

There is no provision in Cr.P.C. which allows a criminal Court to review it's own order, however, given the directions of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, in similar matters, I deem it appropriate not to seek any further report in this regard.

Reply filed by IO in compliance of order dated 09.01.2026, perused.

As per the said reply, IO has submitted that there is a delay of one and half years in filing the charge-sheet after the same was forwarded to Court, on account of law and order duties and other official assignments.

Aforementioned reply is not found satisfactory on account of being vague. In the instant matter, incident to have taken place on 03.09.2022 and charge-sheet has been filed beyond limitation period on 09.01.2026. The said charge-sheet is accompanied by any application seeking condonation of delay in filing the same. Accordingly, cognizance in the instant matter is hereby declined on account of aforementioned.
