

**:- ORDERS ON I.A. No.VII:-**

The I.A.No.VII is filed by the plaintiffs under Order VI Rule 17 of CPC for amendment of plaint. By way of proposed amendment the plaintiffs want to add the additional pleadings to the fact that during the pendency of the suit, the defendant No.1 with an intention to create and concocted title deed by colluding with defendant No.3 to 8 got created the registered partition deed dated 17.12.2014. The said partition deed is null and void and not binding on the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs have also sought for the relief of declaration that the said registered partition deed is not binding on the plaintiffs.

2. The above application is resisted by the defendants by filing their objection. In the objection they have denied the averments of the above application annexed affidavit.

3. Heard the arguments of both side. By way of proposed amendment the plaintiffs want to pleaded about the execution of partition deed dated 17.12.2014 which had taken place subsequent filing of the suit. It is duty of the plaintiffs to bring the subsequent events on record by way of amendment. Therefore, the proposed amendment is necessary for effective adjudication of the dispute between the parties. Hence, in the interest of justice, I proceed to pass the following :-

The I.A.No.VII filed by the plaintiffs under Order VI Rule 17 r/w Sec.151 of CPC is hereby allowed.
