

Counsel for the plaintiffs also files memo praying to dismiss the suit against the Lrs of D1 to 3. No representation on behalf of the Lrs of deceased No. 1 to 3. On perusal of the Lrs of w/s of D 3 (f) and D3 (g), it appears that no counter claim in respect of suit property. In the circumstance, no impleadment to allow the said memo. Accordingly, by allowing the said memo suit against Lrs of deceased defendant No. 1 to 3 dismissed. Plaintiff counsel files IA u/o 6 rule 17 of CPC seeking permission to reduce the measurement of suit schedule property as 2 acre 0.03.08 guntas instead of 2 acre 12 guntas. The learned defendant No. 4 to 9 counsel submits that said IA may be allowed. Heard and allowed the said application as reasons narrated therein justifiable. Plaintiffs counsel carried out amendment and files amended plaint. Both parties and their counsel are present and files compromise petition u/o 23 rule 3

of CPC along with photocopies of their Aadhar cards, sketch copy with present RTC in respect of suit schedule property. On explanation of the averments of compromise petition to the both parties, they submitted that they were resolved the dispute in terms of compromise petition and averments thereof aware to them and signed to the same voluntarily and prayed to accept the same. On perusal of compromise petition along with other documents available on record, this court of the view that the averments of the compromise petition appears to be lawful and no impediment to accept the same. Therefore, compromise petition filed by the both parties u/o XXXIII Rule 3 R/w sec 151 of CPC is hereby allowed. Office shall draw decree in terms of compromise petition.
