Heard on I.A.No.1. The Decree holder has filed the I.A.No.1 under Order 21 Rule 34 R/w.Sec.151 of C.P.C. by seeking appointment of Court Commissioner for executing the Sale Deed in favour of Decree holder.

The Judgment debtors No.1 to 3 are absent. The petition is filed within two years from the date of decree. There is no stay order passed by any Appellate Court by staying the operation of Judgment & Decree obtained by the Decree holder.

As such, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The I.A.No.1 is allowed.

Sri.S.V. Sridhar Advocate is appointed as the Advocate commissioner to execute the Sale Deed in favour of Decree holder.

The Decree holder is directed to deposit Advocate Commissioner's Fee of Rs.5,000/- in the office and he

shall bear all the costs for registration by furnishing necessary stamp papers.

If Commissioner Fee and P.F., along with necessary papers are furnished, then issue Court Commissioner Warrant.
