I S S U E S

1. Whether plaintiffs prove that suit properties were the Inam lands granted to propositus Narsimhappa and he was in lawful possession of the same and after his death children of Narasimhappa have been in possession & enjoyment of the same as lawful owners?
2. Whether plaintiffs prove that one subbaiha S/o Venkataramana Shettar created a bogus sale deed in the name of Narasimhappa in respect of suit properties and in turn the suit properties underwent subsequent alienation at the fraudulent act of defendants no.1 to 5 as averred in para 7 & 8 & 9 of plaint?
3. Whether plaintiffs prove that the defendant have denied their title over suit properties and attempted to interfere for its peaceful enjoyment?
4. Whether defendant no. 5 proves that the original grantee of suit Sy.no. 1/3 measuring 2A 13C Narasimaha sold the said land to one Subbanna

which being his self acquired property for his family necessity, under registered sale deed dated 20-1-64 and handedover vacant possession to that and in turn Subbaiha sold it to Rajanna under sale deed dated 8-7-1970 and she has purchased 33 guntas in Sy.no. 1/3 from Rajanna and she has been in lawful possession of the same?

5. Whether the suit is barred by limitation?
6. Whether defendant no.6 proves that the suit properties were the self acquired properties of Narasimhappa and the plaintiffs have no right over that property and the alienation of the properties by him is valid and those sale deeds cannot be cancelled?
7. Whether the valuation of suit is improper and the payment of court fee is insufficient?
8. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief of declaration of their ownership over suit properties and for cancellation of sale deeds and for permanent injunction as prayed for?
9. What order or decree?
