- 4) Whether the defendant No.2 to 6 prove that, the plaintiff has already obtained her share by way of gold ornaments and valuable things during her marriage and therefore, she is not entitled for partition?
- 5) Whether the plaintiff is entitled for the relieves as sought for?
- 6) What order or decree?
