ISSUES

- 1) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, plaintiffs and defendant No.1 to 10 are the members of Hindu joint family and they are in possession of the suit schedule properties as their ancestral and joint family properties?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs further prove that, since they are having 2/3rd share in the properties, the mutation entry in the names of defendant No.11 in respect of 'A' schedule property and mutation entry in the name of defendant No.2 in respect of 'B' schedule property are not binding on them?
- 3) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, in spite of said mutation entries effected in the year 1987 and 1992 the suit is filed by them within limitation period?
- 4) Whether the defendants No.2 and 4 prove that, in the year 1937 itself the 1st defendant and his sons have effected oral partition?
- 5) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relieves as sought for?
- 6) What order or decree?
