Muniyappa was the absolute owner of the suit schedule property as it was his self acquired property and he had sold a portion of the same under Registered Sale Deed dated 31.12.2008 in favour of defendant No.5 and it is valid Sale Deed?
- 4) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relieves claimed?
- 5) What Order or Decree?
