Heard on I.A.No. 1. Perused the documents. The plaintiff has filed this suit against the defendants for the relief of partition and separate possession in respect of plaint schedule properties.

The plaintiff has produced the documents showing the properties are joint family properties having acquired by way of inheritance on the death of Lachappa and Papamma and it is the apprehension of the plaintiff that, the defendants are trying to alienate the plaint schedule properties in favour of third parties. Therefore, the Court proceeds to pass the following;

## **ORDER**

I.A.No. 1 is allowed.

The defendant No.1 to 21 are restrained from alienating the plaint schedule properties by way of ex-parte temporary injunction order till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply the Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C. provisions.

He shall issue summons to the defendants by furnishing plaint, I.A. copies and all the documents. Office to issue certified copy of the order only after compliance.

If the plaintiff did not comply the above order in letter and spirit, the temporary injunction order shall not be continued on the next date of hearing.
