I S S U E S

- 1) Whether the plaintiff proves that, she herself and defendants constitutes Hindu undivided joint family?
- 2) Whether the plaintiff proves that, the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of herself and defendants?
- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that, she is entitled for partition and separate possession of her share in the suit schedule properties?
- 4) Whether the defendant No.1 proves that, his father by name Narasimhaiah was the owner of suit item No.3 & 4 properties and other properties, and who inturn bequeathed part of suit item No.3 and 4 property in his favour by executing will deed dated 29-12-2007?
- 5) Whether the defendant No.2 & 3 proves that, the preliminary decree has already been passed in O.S.No.373/1996 where in the court has considered the share of father of plaintiff and defendant No.1 as a half share and plaintiff needs to claim her share in the said half share of her father. Therefore there is no necessity to again determine the rights of Parties?
- 6) What order or decree?
