The plaintiff has filed the present suit for the relief of partition and separate possession.

Along with the plaint, the plaintiff has submitted I.A.No.1 under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 R/w Sec.151 of C.P.C. seeking to restrain the defendants from alienating the suit schedule property till disposal of suit.

Heard.

On going through the plaint and the documents on record, there is reasonable apprehension of suit schedule property being sold in favour of 3<sup>rd</sup> person. If the temporary injunction is not granted at this stage, there is possibility of rights of plaintiff being curtailed. In order to avoid multiplicity of proceedings it is necessary to pass restraining order in respect of I.A. No.1. In view of this I proceed to pass the following :

**ORDER**

The defendants are restrained by way of ex-parte ad-interim temporary injunction from alienating the suit property to the 3<sup>rd</sup> parties till next date of hearing.

The plaintiff shall comply order 39 Rule 3 A of C.P.C. in respect of I.A. No.1.
