- 3) Whether the plaintiff proves that the sale deeds dated 22-02-2002, 27-02-2002, 05-05-1995 and gift deed dated 25-01-2008 is not binding on her?
- 4) Whether the plaintiff proves that the will dated 17-05-1995 is not binding on her?
- 5) Whether the plaintiff proves that the alleged release deed dated 17-05-1995 is created by the 2nd defendant and 7th defendant by fraud?
- 6) Whether the suit is maintainable U/Sec. 6 of Hindu Succession Act?
- 7) Whether this suit is properly valued and court fee paid is sufficient?

- 8) Whether this suit is barred by law of limitation?
- 9) Whether the plaintiffs are entitled for the relief as sought for?
- 10) What order or decree?
