This is the suit for Partition and Separate Possession.

I.A. No. I is filed U/O.39 Rule 1 and 2 of C.P.C. seeking temporary injunction against the defendants, restraining them from alienating the suit schedule properties pending disposal of the suit.

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff and perused the plaint, I.A.No.I, affidavit and suit documents.

On perusal of the records, it appears that the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case that the defendants are trying to alienate the suit schedule properties. Hence, the plaintiff has made out prima-facie case at this stage, to grant ex-parte ad-

interim order of temporary injunction against the defendants, restraining them from alienating the suit schedule properties in any manner till next date of hearing, otherwise, it leads to multiplicity of proceedings and very purpose of the filing of this suit will be defeated. Accordingly, the following;

ORDER

As per I.A.No.I issue an ex-parte ad-interim order of temporary injunction against the defendants, restraining them from alienating the suit schedule properties in any manner till next date of hearing.

The plaintiffs to comply Order 39 Rule 3 of C.P.C. forthwith.

Issue temporary injunction notice of I.A.No.I and suit summons to all the defendants.

It is made it clear that, if the office found deficit process fee or plaint copies, same shall be complied within three days, or else the interim order will be cancelled automatically.
