- 1) Whether the Plaintiffs prove that, they themselves and defendants constitute Hindu undivided joint family?
- 2) Whether the plaintiffs prove that, the suit schedule properties are the ancestral and joint family properties of themselves and defendants?
- 3) Whether the Plaintiffs prove that, they are entitled for share in the suit properties?
- 4) Whether the defendant No.3 proves that, the suit properties were the exclusive property of his grant mother Akkayamma who is bequeathed the same in his favour by vide will deed dated 22-05-1965 and therefore he is the owner of suit property by virtue of sale deed?.
- 5) Whether the defendant No.3 proves that, the said Akkyamma had also bequeathed same other properties to mother of Plaintiff by name Nanjamma and Lakshamma and they have alienated the said properties?

- 6) Whether the defendant No.2 proves that, the suit properties and other properties mentioned in her Written Statement are the joint family properties and in which she has got share?
- 7) What order or decree?
