O R D E R

1. Arguments heard on the bail application filed by Pardeep Singh under section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail. Notice of this bail application was given to Additional PP for the State who appeared and contested it.

2. As per the prosecution version complainant Paramjit Kaur reported the matter to the police that on 10.09.2016 her marriage was solemnized with Pardeep Singh son of Joginder Singh resident of Ajnala but actual name of Pardeep Singh is Sandeep Singh son of Mukhtiar Singh. The other family members of Pardeep Singh also concealed their actual names. After the marriage she was harassed by her in-laws for bringing insufficient dowry. Her

forcible abortion was got conducted. Moreover, Pardeep Singh again changed his name and has solemnized second marriage with Karamjit Kaur d/o Joginder Singh resident of U.P. The accused/applicant alongwith others has stolen her Istridhan also and got her pregnancy terminated. So, on this, FIR was registered.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant has argued that applicant is falsely implicated. He is innocent and has been implicated in this case due to matrimonial dispute with his wife and a petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act is pending before the family Court. The complainant herself has withdrawn from the society of the respondent. Applicant is in judicial custody from a long period. Co-accused have been granted bail. He will abide by the terms and conditions of bail order and prayer is made for grant of bail.

4. Whereas the learned Additional PP assisted by Shri R.S. Chhina, Advocate, counsel for the complainant has opposed the bail application stating that there are serious allegations against the applicant. He has impersonated as Sandeep Singh and performed second marriage with complainant and pregnancy of complainant was also terminated and dowry articles have been misappropriated. So, applicant is not entitled to concession of bail.

5. Heard. Record perused. As per record the accused/applicant not only impersonated and by changing his name has contracted second marriage with the complainant but he has also got the pregnancy of complainant terminated. There are serious allegations against the applicant that inspite of first marriage he has contracted second marriage with complainant and forged the marriage

certificate given by Gurudwara authorities. So, keeping in view the said facts and gravity of matter the applicant is not entitled to concession of bail. Hence, the bail application is hereby dismissed.

6. Anything observed herein will have no effect on the merits of the case. Record of bail application be consigned to the record room.
