ORDER

1. Present bail application has been filed by above named
accused/applicant under the provisions of Section 483 BNSS in FIR
No.76 dated 20.05.2025, under Sections 15/27 of NDPS Act, registered at
Police Station City-2, Mansa.

2. Notice of the bail application has been issued to the State. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has appeared. Police record has been produced.

3. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant submits that applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Further submits that nothing intoxicant has been got recovered from the possession of the present applicant/accused and recovery shown to be effected is the planted one. Further submits that applicant/accused is behind the bars since 20.05.2025 and completion of investigation and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time and thus, prays that present bail application may kindly be allowed.

4. Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that in the present case, applicant/accused has been apprehended and 19 kg of poppy husk has been got recovered from his conscious possession. Further submits that there are 13 more FIRs registered against the present applicant/accused, out of which 11 FIRs are under NDPS Act. Further submits that vide rapat No.21 dated 24.05.2025 offence under Section 27 of NDPS Act has been added. Further submits that applicant/accused is a habitual offender and thus, prays that present bail application may kindly be dismissed.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the accused/applicant, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State and perusal of the record, it reflects that in the present case applicant/accused has been apprehended by the police being found to be in conscious possession of 19 kg of poppy

husk. It is the fact that applicant/accused is behind the bars since 20.05.2025 and till date chemical examiner report has not been received. Further it is also brought on the record by the prosecution that there are 13 more FIRs registered against the applicant/accused and out of said 13 FIRs, 11 FIRs are under NDPS Act, out of which in 4 FIRs applicant/accused has been convicted. Thus, it means that applicant/accused is reflected to be a habitual offender. So, taken into consideration the above said fact and circumstances of the case and the act and conduct of the applicant/accused reflected from the 13 FIRs registered against applicant/accused, this court do not find any satisfactory ground to grant concession of bail to the present applicant/accused and as such, present bail application is dismissed. File be attached with the the remand papers.
